This is just a reminder that the Joint Chapter meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 31st this year.

There were a number of important action items identified for each of the individual Chapters and Groups at the last Excom meeting.

- 1. To maintain and grow the membership of the Rochester IEEE Section.
- 2. To enhance the communication of events to IEEE members and all engineering communities in the Rochester section.
  - a. Create new web pages.
  - b. Create a new template and format for monthly newsletters.
  - c. Continuation of monthly Section Chair's notes in the newsletter.
- 3. To improve networking within the Rochester IEEE Section through:
  - a. Three major sectional events including: A. Joint Chapter meeting, B. Summer event, and C. Volunteers appreciation dinner.
  - b. Three casual networking only events that engage the local industry with the goal of improving industry relations with IEEE.
- 4. To support the engineering profession from the bottom up.
  - a. ALL outreach programs will be financially covered by the Section budget (with preapproval from the section) and will not be drawn from the budget of the smaller organizational units and chapters.
  - b. Incentives will be created for student groups to create three or more outreach programs in 2015.
  - c. Continued support and involvement in the E3 Fair to increase engineering interest in middle school students.
  - d. Create a process for providing an IEEE Rochester Section Graduate Fellowship (in tandem with the undergraduate fellowships that are already awarded annually).
  - e. Create PACE activities that include three or more minor professional development sectional events that provide PDH credit. We will build off of the first PDH credit seminar that were created in 2014. The goal of these sectional events will be to support the R1 Directors initiative in preparing and supporting career development in R1.
