The Nokia Bell Labs New Jersey Regional Science Fair (NJRSF):

The Nokia Bell Labs NJRSF is just round the corner and our section will be involved in this event that promotes STEM education among high school children. **The Nokia Bell Labs NJRSF is a high school student science competition** in which students, individually or in groups, present a wide variety of projects. Most of the projects are investigative in nature, posing and attempting to answer some question or problem, either through experimentation and design or in a theoretical sense. All areas of science, math, and engineering are included. The fair accepts entries from ten counties of northern New Jersey: Bergen, Essex, Hunterdon, Middlesex, Morris, Passaic, Somerset. The mission of the Nokia Bell Labs NJRSF, found on the website, is to support, encourage, and recognize student involvement in scientific research. It is our belief that students can only truly appreciate the creative nature of the scientific process if they have actually experienced it themselves. In addition, we endeavor to provide resources which further this overarching goal, including giving students various opportunities to interact with professional scientists and engineers. The opportunity to partake of the NJRSF itself as well as the other resources we offer is intended to be open to all high school students in the northern NJ region. Sussex, Union, and Warren. Another event promoting STEM education where our section will be actively involved in the judging is the Hudson County's STEM Showcase 2022. This program was founded by The Jersey Journal as the Hudson County Science Fair and is now run by Jersey City Medical Center-RWJ Barnabas Health.

Edison Electric Cars

With all the talk about the importance of charging electric vehicles in our home garages, many Americans think this is something so radically new we must have an immediate national effort to encourage it.

Today, you can see Tom Edison's original electric vehicle garage charging station at his Glenmont Garage, located at the Thomas Edison National Historical Park, in West Orange, NJ. The point of all this is Tom was charging electric vehicles in this facility way back at the turn of the last century--quite some time ago; and he did so until his death in 1931. Did I mention his station could re-charge three vehicles simultaneously?

His equipment was bulky of course and reflected the state of the art back then, whereas today's equipment is easily wall-mounted and convenient to use. And thanks to Elon Musk (and others), you can integrate battery and electric vehicle re-charging with solar (photovoltaic) panels on the roof of a home.

I can almost hear Mr. Edison lamenting....."C'mon folks, what are you waiting for?"

By the way, Edison was experimenting with electric trucks as well in the 1920's / 30's. Did you folks at Ford hear this?
