- Across regions (more details on Collabratec MD Volunteers):
 - Membership is up 6.9% YoY (July)
 - Student membership accounts for 85% of growth
 - Higher grade membership is up 1.4%
- 2024 Membership renewal starts in September
- New members get membership benefits through end of 2024
