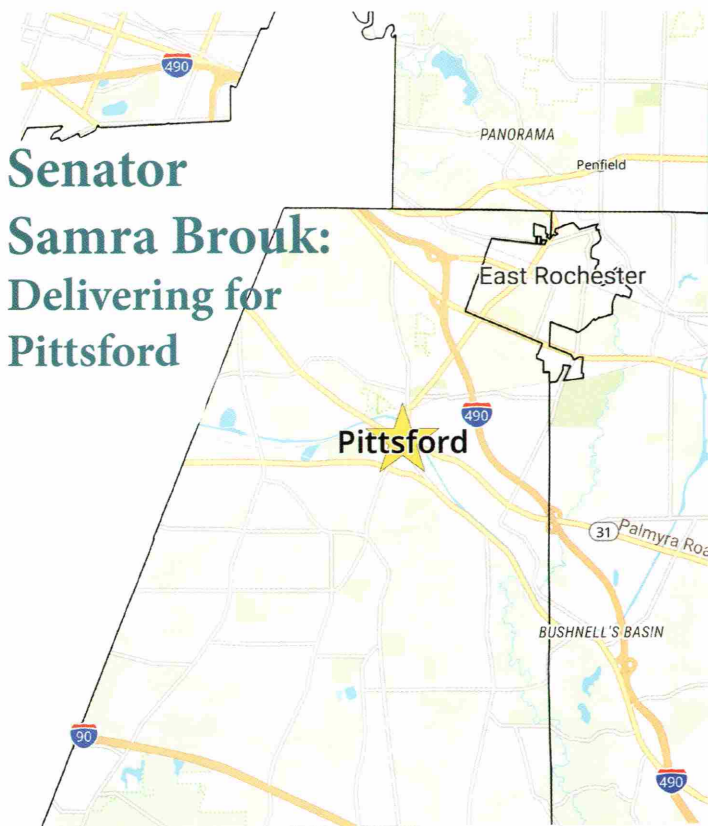

Funding Highlights for Monroe County and NYS


- **Over \$1B for schools in SD-55** (including the Rochester City School District) – a **\$19.7M increase** over last year*
- **\$15.9M for the Department of Veterans' Services**, as well as **\$250,000 for the Veterans Outreach Center**, and **\$192,000 for the Joseph P. Dwyer Veteran Peer to Peer Services Program of Monroe County**
- **\$525M for hospital services**, **\$285M to nursing homes**, and **\$15M to assisted living programs** statewide
- **A record \$10M increase to upstate public transit**, for a total of **\$333.2M**
- **\$1.78B for the NYS Child Care Block Grant**, providing assistance for 119,000 eligible children
- **Increased AIM funding for the first time in 15 years**, providing our municipalities with long overdue financial support
- **\$55.7M for the largest expansion of the Tuition Assistance Program (TAP)** in two decades, and increased the minimum TAP award from \$500 to **\$1,000**
- **Prioritized community well-being and public safety with \$25M in anti-poverty funding**, nearly **\$3M for the Gun Involved Violence Elimination (GIVE) initiative** in Monroe County, and an additional **\$750,000 investment in the Rochester-Monroe Anti-Poverty Initiative**

Listening to Pittsford: Community-Inspired Investments

- **Over \$443,000** to maintain our roads in Pittsford
- **\$125,613 in AIM funding** to Pittsford to support local services
- **\$110,000 for the Pittsford Community Library** for building improvements and services for our community²
- **\$20,000 for the Pittsford Volunteer Ambulance**, expanding access to community health services³
- **\$250,000 for the Pittsford Fire District**⁴
- **\$396,000 for repaving, sidewalk installation, and improving accessibility** in Pittsford¹
